### PARKING ON CAMPUS IS A PRIVILEGE

- ◆ Parking spaces are not guaranteed. Please note: if you have a free first period parking may be limited. Please plan accordingly.
- ◆ Parking spaces cannot be saved or marked by students.
- ◆ You may only park on campus with a vehicle approved through this process and displayed Student Parking Permit. (If a second car is driven, you must complete a separate application. For one day or emergency parking, please check in at the Assistant Principals' office before school.
- ◆ You must park **ONLY** in student parking. Parking in staff and visitor parking lots will result in a parking citation and fine.
- ◆ You must follow all posted signs and drive in a safe and courteous manner.
- ◆ You must secure your vehicles and are responsible for its contents.
- ◆ Parking Lots are monitored by Encinitas Sheriff's Department and SDA staff. Failure to follow posted signs or SDA Student Parking Policy will result in a citation and fine.
- ◆ Student and parent have attended a district Start Smart presentation. (See reverse side for information.)

## START SMART DRIVING SAFETY CLASS

**Start Smart Driving Safety Class** is a free driver safety education class that targets students between the ages of 15-20 years old and their parents/guardians. All San Dieguito Union High School students and their parents/guardian **must attend** a Start Smart class in order to obtain a parking permit to park on their school campus.

Officers from the San Diego County Sheriff Department – Encinitas Substation and California Highway Patrol’s offices will discuss traffic avoidance techniques, collision causing factors, driver/parent responsibilities and seatbelt usage.

The Start Smart class provides an opportunity for teens and their parents/guardians to discuss the serious laws, obligations and responsibilities, and family expectations that are part of driving a car.
