SUBJECT: SDUHSD EMPLOYEE NAMED ONE OF CALIFORNIA'S CLASSIFIED SCHOOL EMPLOYEES OF THE YEAR

ENCINITAS – State Superintendent of Public Instruction Tom Torlakson announced yesterday that Bridget Sabin, San Dieguito Academy Registrar, was named one of California's 2017 Classified School Employees of the Year.



The annual program honors outstanding classified school employees from six categories including Office and Technical Support, the category in which Ms. Sabin was awarded. This year's recipients were chosen from more than 100 nominations statewide.

Ms. Sabin was one of the original staff when the high school was renamed in the mid-1990s, and she remains an energetic, popular, and beloved figure on campus. As the one and only registrar, she is responsible for a range of duties including checking every student's transcript to ensure they are on pace for graduation, registering all freshmen and transfer students as they enroll at the school, and even organizing an "Angel Tree" gift program during the holiday season for less fortunate students. Ms. Sabin remains caring and kind regardless of daily work pressures or deadlines.
