

We hope you're enjoying your summer vacation! Taking Care of Business Day (TCB) forms and information can be found on our website: <u>www.sd.sduhsd.net</u>.

Prior to Taking Care of Business Days (TCB), parents need to verify and update their information as part of the reregistration process using the Aeries Parent Portal for each child. An email will be sent from the district confirming the need for re-registration. During the re-registration process, please verify and complete each section. You will be able to make changes to the information about your child if necessary. Instructions on how to update the information can be found at <u>my.sduhsd.net</u>. Information about what to bring on TCB Day and the Finance Office Checklist is attached. Please read, print, sign and return the following MANDATORY forms on your TCB day:

- Emergency Form On the Aeries Parent Portal, you must print out a hard copy
- Signature Verification Form On sd.sduhsd.net

Other important forms can also be downloaded and brought to TCB day if these apply to your family. Also on the website, you can download other pertinent information such as bell schedules, calendar, textbook policy, Mustang Athletics, and health office information. The PSAT will be held on Saturday, October 14. More information about the test is on the reverse side of this letter.

Attend Taking Care of Business days – Get your class schedule, get your school ID card, have your yearbook picture taken, see friends and lots more! Counselors will be available. Bring the TWO MANDATORY forms listed above at this time. (See the attached TCB information for more details.) Taking Care of Business days are as follows:

Seniors: Friday, August 18 Juniors: Monday, August 21 Sophomores: Tuesday, August 22 Freshmen: Wednesday, August 23

Make-up day: Wednesday, August 23, 12:30-2:00 p.m. If you cannot attend on these dates, all forms must be turned in before school on August 29. Students cannot attend classes until all mandatory forms have been turned in.

- ➡ Freshmen Orientation/Link Crew Tuesday, August 22, 7:30 a.m.-1:00 p.m. Take a tour of our campus, get to know the upperclassmen, and learn all about SDA! This is highly recommended for ALL new students.
- ▶ New Parent Orientation Wednesday, August 23, 7:30-noon. Parents, while your student participates in TCB we invite you to participate in our Parent Orientation. Are you a fall sport athlete? Sports packages are available on the website. Just click on *Athletics*, then *Sports Packet*. You need to complete all paperwork in the package in order to get your eligibility card. Once a completed sports packet has been turned in to the Athletic Office, the student will receive a clearance card to take to tryouts. No one will be permitted to try out until they have received a clearance card. Try out dates and times will be posted on the website.
